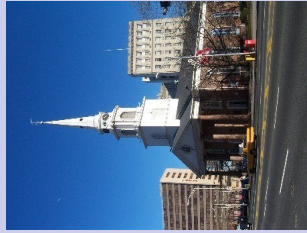

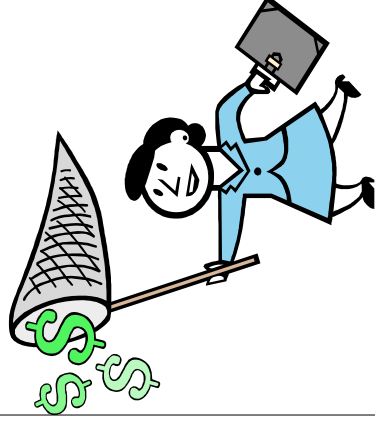

Growing More Stewardship Mentors

Assistant to the Bishop for Stewardship in the Diocese of Western Massachusetts and former President of the board of the Episcopal Network for Stewardship (TENS), has been involved in stewardship formation ministries for over 25 years.

He is known for reminding people of the power of their own personal stories in stewardship formation and for successful techniques to enhance conversion and transformation to sacrificial and joyful Christian stewardship.

Bruce will lead the training session for mentors, which will culminate in the mentors planning and facilitating a workshop for stewardship volunteers on the third day
