1. **Diocese Asking**. It is calculated using the average of the last 3 years of reported income to the Episcopal Church in the Diocese's Annual Report.

2. **3 Year Average calculation**

- a. Used the last 3 years of diocese income as reported to the Episcopal Church on the Diocese's Annual Report.
- b. Where a Diocese's reported income was not available, the Provincial Council will need to recalculation the 3 year average once the reports are received.
- c. We are most appreciative for the efforts of Kurt Barnes, Episcopal Church Treasurer and Sheila Golden in providing the 2016 reported incomes as there was no report readily available for public dissemination.

3. **Asking Percentage**. The Asking Percentage has been reduced to .3%

4. **Asking Amount 2019**. This is the product of the 3 Yr Average times the Asking Percentage and is the starting point for estimating the Diocese's Askings for 2020 and 2021.
